



JUBILEE MAKES CHANGES AHEAD OF PARTY NOMINATIONS

The Jubilee Party National Executive Committee this morning held a special meeting chaired by Party Leader H.E. President Uhuru Kenyatta in the presence of the Deputy Party Leader, William Ruto.

The NEC made changes to the party structures to better align with the party constitution.

Raphael Tuju will continue as Head of Secretariat and also take over as Secretary General. Veronica Maina becomes the Deputy Chair in charge of strategy in the party hierarchy.

The NEC also endorsed the strengthening of the party nomination structures by adding two more lawyers to fulfill the requirement of the party constitution. The NEC assigned responsibilities with respect to the organs that will oversee the nomination process as follows:

1. Mr Andrew Musangi - Chairman of the National Elections Board
2. Mr Muchai Lumatete - Chairman of the Disciplinary Committee
3. Ms Faith Waigwa - Chairman of the Appeals Tribunal

While making the announcement of the organisational changes, the President gave thanks to Mrs. Maina

“I would first and foremost wish to take this opportunity to thank our sister Veronica who has navigated the stormy waters of bringing our parties together, TNA and URP plus the very many other parties that have agreed to collapse themselves into Jubilee. We thank you Veronica for that effort. It was not easy but we appreciate the hard work that you have put into that effort at the same time.”

Speaking at the party headquarters, Mr Tuju reiterated the commitment of the Jubilee party to a new style of politics

“Jubilee represents something truly progressive in Kenyan politics. A sincerely national, representative and post-tribal political party, that will campaign on the basis of a shared vision for the country’s future. A party that will stand by a manifesto and offer Kenyans a real choice at the ballot box.”



Tuju will now steer the party through the critical election period, helping to oversee the party's nomination process and the production of a progressive manifesto upon which Jubilee will campaign.
